

## Maths

### Year 1

In year one we will be following the Inspire scheme of work which focuses on a CPA (concrete, pictorial, abstract). We will move on to focus on numbers up to 20 and look at addition and subtraction facts. We will also a look at 2d and 3d shapes by naming them, classifying them and describing their properties. Within our shape work we will identify patterns and repeat them. In Numbersense we will continue to work on the mental strategies within 10 and these will be sent home each week with suggestions for work at home.

**Vocabulary:** *altogether, less than, more than, fewer, greater, cube, cuboid, sphere, prism.*

### Year 2

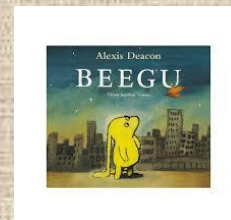
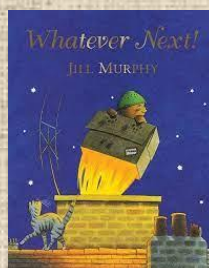
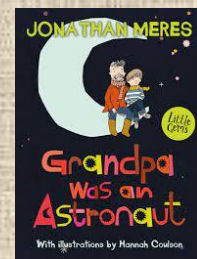
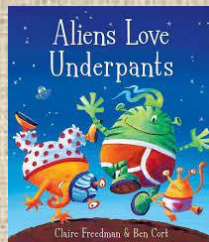
In maths, the year twos will continue to build upon their understanding of place value, as well as learning to add and subtract numbers within 40 using different written and mental strategies. They will also develop their understanding of multiplication through 'repeated addition' and learn the skip-counting method for their two, five and ten times tables.

**Vocabulary:** *tens, ones, place value, nearest, number bond, repeated addition, multiply, groups of, lots of, skip counting.*

## English

We will continue with Read Write Inc four times weekly to teach and practice our understanding of phonics. On a Monday morning, the children will continue to have their 'Let's Write' lesson in which they will write newspaper articles, chronological reports and character/setting descriptions. We will also write Letters to Father Christmas and create our own Christmas narratives later in the term.

## Jigsaw (PSHE)
