Pre-Loved Sale and Bags 2 School

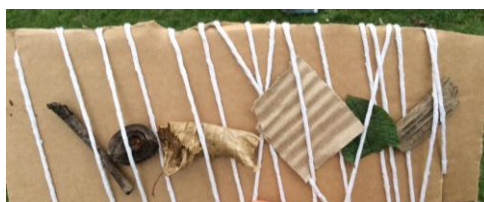

A snapshot of learning for this week:

Explorers have been exploring all things Spring and enjoying their Tuesday PE!



Adventurers have been finding out the differences between the seeds of fruit and vegetables. They have also created natural storyboards that tell a story to be acted out (helicopter stories).



Voyagers have been looking at a new version of Jack and the beanstalk, called Jim and the beanstalk and have started to write diary entries. They have started to learn a new country dance and planted their beans ready to see what will happen to them in different conditions. They have designed gardens based on the book 'the paradise garden' that contain human and physical features of geography in them.

Navigators and Pioneers have been comparing the themes and language of The Butterfly Lion and their autumn read, Lob. They have been getting stuck in to their Mayan mask making and carefully using papiermache to create a structure to build up their features.

A snapshot of learning for next week:

Explorers will be focussing their activities around Easter.

Adventurers will be exploring the question: 'Whose mum is who?'

Voyagers will be becoming artists and are going to look at still life drawing. They will be starting to understand how to add and subtract money in year 2 and they will continue to learn new songs about the Jack and the Beanstalk story. Year 1 will be using the words fewer, greater, smallest, greatest in their maths work to create maths sentences.

Navigators and Pioneers will be exploring Mexican cuisine and planning a Mexican picnic. They will also finish their masks and begin their printmaking using tiles inspired by William Morris.
