### **Admissions to Nursery**

Applications for spaces must be submitted in the half term before your child starts at Explorers. Government funded hours can be used towards any session and we also accept childcare vouchers. All children are eligible for universal 15 hours funding, the term following their 3rd birthday, with some able to extend this to 30 hours.
